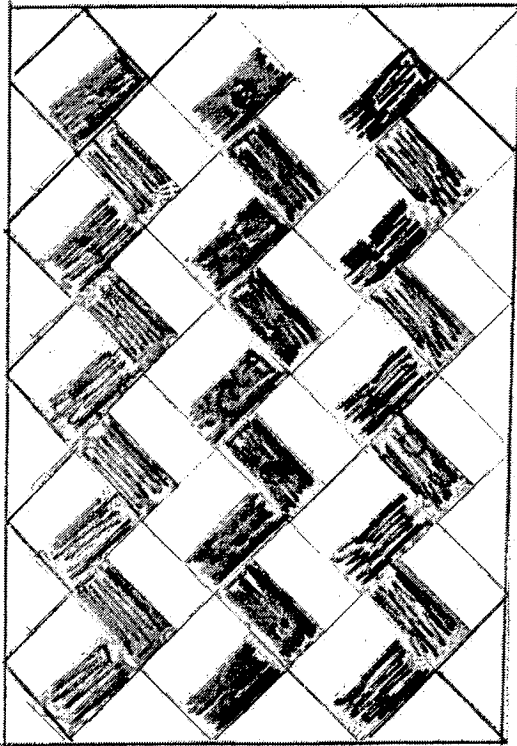


Super Zig Zag Quilt



Included in your kit:

Background Fabric: 1.5 yards
3 different fabrics for zig zags: 9"
Binding: 15"
Backing: 61"
Batting: 61"

This quilt is a smaller version of the Super Zig free quilt pattern found at <http://www.lecien.co.jp/en/hobby/patterns/img/superzig.pdf>

Finished quilt size: 40" by 57".

General instructions:

1. Review all information provided with the kit. Before beginning, match the fabric pieces included with the kit instructions.
2. Quilts need to be machine quilted or hand quilted. Quilting can be plain in-the-ditch or as elaborate as you wish to quilt it. Tied quilts do not have the durability for multiple washings, and we ask you not to secure your quilt by that method.
3. If you need assistance in order to complete the quilt, please contact one of the committee members. This program strives to accomplish two goals: It helps us provide quilts to the many worthwhile groups/agencies we serve, and we aim to assist novice quilters to learn basic quilting skills in the process.
4. Remember, a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance is used for all seams.

Cutting:

1. From each of the three 9" pieces of fabric, cut nine 4 1/2" by 8 1/2" rectangles.
2. From background fabric cut:
 - a. Three strips 8 1/2" by width of fabric. Subcut these into 27 4 1/2" by 8 1/2" rectangles
 - b. Two strips 12 5/8" inches by width of fabric. Subcut these into four 12 5/8" by 12 5/8" squares, and then cut each square diagonally twice to yield 15 side triangles.
 - c. From the fabric left over from step (b) above, cut one 6 5/8" square, and cut the square in half diagonally to yield 2 corner triangles.

Assembly:

1. Join a 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" background rectangle with a 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" print rectangle along the 8 1/2" side to make a square. Make 27.



2. Arrange the zig zag square, side triangles and corner triangles as shown in the quilt illustration. Join into rows. Press rows in alternating directions. Join rows to complete the quilt top.

Prepare backing, sandwich with batting, quilt as desired.

Bind the quilt using the enclosed directions.

Attach the enclosed label.
